



*Dean v Utica* (2004) clarified much that was vague in *Hazelwood*.

The *Arrow*, the student paper at Utica High School in Utica, Michigan, had attempted to publish an article about a couple, the Frances, who were suing the school district, claiming the idling diesel buses in the school garage next to their home had caused the husband's cancer. The principal ordered the students to pull the story, an accompanying editorial and a cartoon. The students published a black box with the word "Censored" across it in white lettering, and an editorial on censorship. A local newspaper later published Dean's censored article.
